Lugano:

Lugano, the largest town in the holiday region of Ticino, is not only Switzerland's third most important financial centre and a conference, banking and business centre, but also a town of parks and flowers, villas and sacred buildings. With Mediterranean flair, Lugano offers all the advantages of a world-class city, combined with the cachet of a small town.

Must See

Parco Civico Ciani - Overlooking the shores of lake Ceresio, its 63.000 sq. metres constitute the city's green lung; it's a quiet place where you can take nice walks and where it is impossible unperturbed by the of remain grandeur century Monte Brè (925 m) - Lugano's closest mountain can be reached by funicular railway from Cassarate on the outskirts of Lugano and offers wonderful panorama of the town, lake and stretching right the border mountains. over into Italy. Monte San Salvatore (912 m) - From the top of the "sugarloaf" (reached by funicular railway from Lugano-Paradiso) you can walk down the panoramic footpath to Carona and then on to Morcote.

San Lorenzo Cathedral - Set above the Old Town, it is worth a visit. The Cathedral's facade is in the Lombardy Renaissance style, and it has countless frescoes and valuable Baroque artefacts inside.

Church of Santa Maria degli Angioli - In this former monastery church, built around the year 1500, are fine frescoes by the masters of the Renaissance. **Tourist Train of Lugano -** A tour of the City aboard the train "La freccia rossa" (the red arrow). **Swiss Miniatur -** A must for families. The open-air museum where one can admire the most important Swiss buildings and means of transportation is a delight for adults and children alike. Their restaurant offers local, Chinese and Indian cuisine.

Zermatt:

Zermatt lies at the foot of the Matterhorn. The town's touristic development is closely linked to what is most probably the world's most famous mountain. Zermatt epitomises the image of Switzerland: high-alpine, awe-inspiring and original.

Must See

Matterhorn Glacier Paradise/Klein Matterhorn - The highest place in Europe (3883 m) that can be reached by a cableway, with a viewing platform and the highest glacier palace in the world.

Matterhorn Museum - Houses the items of equipment used during the first ascent of the ended Matterhorn 1865 which tragically. Rothorn Paradise - The Rothorn Paradise gives you a view of the Matterhorn from its most beautiful side. The view of the Dufourspitze and the Weisshorn with the Matterhorn looming between them is just breathtaking. Sunnegga Paradise - The paradise for families. From Zermatt, you can arrive at the Sunnegga paradise (2,288 m. above sea level) in only 3 minutes with the underground funicular railway. From the spacious sun terrace of the restaurant, you can then enjoy a wonderful view of the Matterhorn.

Gornergrat -With its viewing platform that can be reached throughout the year, the Gornergrat, at an altitude of 3,089 m above sea level, has been a big attraction for the last 111 years.

Gorner gorge - A footpath across narrow bridges and steps as well as a fixed rope route guide visitors through the deeply scarped gorge.

Village of Findeln - Original Valais settlement with a small chapel; it has Switzerland's highest rye crop fields at an altitude of 2100 metres.

Helicopter sightseeing flight - Eye-to eye with mountaineers, and a bird's eye view of the imposing peaks that surround Zermatt.

Montreux:

The town of Montreux nestles in a sheltered Lake Geneva bay, surrounded by vineyards and against the breathtaking backdrop of snow-covered Alps. The Montreux Jazz Festival, which takes place in June/July and features concerts on a variety of stages and parks is very famous.

Must See

Rochers-de-Naye -The Rochers-de-Naye rack-railway, after overcoming a difference in altitude of 1600 metres, reaches one of the most beautiful vantage points in western Switzerland.

Golden Pass Line - The panorama train operates between Montreux, Gstaad and the Bernese Oberland with connections Lucerne. **Lake Geneva Shipping Company -** The ships, some of which are still powered by paddles, visitors to the picturesque lakeside **Chillon Castle -** Located on a rocky island near the shore featuring fortified walls and towers; the prison in which Bonivard was held in chains for four years and which provided Lord Byron with the inspiration for his famous poem "The prisoners of Chillon" in 1816 deserves particular attention. Nowadays museum. Montreux Jazz Festival - Since its beginning in 1967 the festival has developed into a big event which frequently features the greatest jazz, blues, rock, world music and soul musicians (June/July).

Comedy Festival - The humour festival every year brings together the most famous comedians from the French-, German- and English-speaking areas (December). **Christmas Market** - One of Switzerland's famous Christmas Markets with numerous attractions and over one hundred decorated wooden houses brimming with gifts (December).

Interlaken:

Interlaken lies in the Bernese Oberland between Lake Thun and Lake Brienz. This vacation destination, which is presided over by the three mighty mountains, Eiger, Mönch and Jungfrau, is the starting point for numerous activities.

Must See

Jungfraujoch - Top of Europe: The highest railway station in Europe, which guarantees 365 days of ice. Schynige Platte near Wilderswil - Nostalgic rackrailway, fascinating view of Eiger, Monch and Jungfrau, Alpine garden with about 500 plant species and a lot of hiking possibilities. Harder Kulm - A cableway takes passengers up to Interlaken's "home mountain" which affords a view of the health resort and the whole Jungfrau region. The Alpine wild animal park near the station experience valley for children. Heimwehfluh - A nostalgic funicular provides transport to the vantage terrace with a restaurant, weather toboggan run model railway display and large playground.
