## SPAIN WITH MOROCCO

08 NIGHTS / 09 DAYS

(2N MADRID; 1N SEVILLA; 1N GRANADA; 1N MALAGA; 1N CASABLANCA; 1N FEZ; 1N MARRAKESH)

### ITINERARY:

#### DAY 1 MADRID:

Welcome to Spain! Arrival in Madrid airport, transfer and check in your hotel. Rest of the day at disposal for the discovery of Madrid, the Capital of Spain.

#### DAY 2 MADRID:

Breakfast in your hotel. Start of Madrid city tour. There is no to get to know a city than by admiring its monuments and the people as they walk around its most emblematic streets and We will take a walk through the narrow and steep streets of the part of Madrid that will show us emblematic locations such as the walls, Segovia Street, Mayor Street, Plaza Mayor, Plaza de la the Royal Palace, former residence of the Spanish Kings.

short drive to Toledo for an interesting city tour. The city of Three Cultures will captive your attention at first sight. Its impressive old town, surrounded by the river, will offer a unique landscape for your camera. Inside we will walk along centuries-old street to see the Cathedral, the Sto Tome Church, with the masterpiece of El Greco “the burial of Count Orgaz” and the Synagogue.

#### DAY 3 MADRID – CORDOBA – SEVILLA:

After breakfast transportation to Cordoba. Discover all the charm of this andalusian city, walking through the narrow streets of the old Jewish quarters and visiting its main highlight “the unique old Mosque”. Continue to Sevilla in the afternoon and start a guided tour that will give you an inside into Sevilla, one of the most beautiful cities and largest historical centers in Europe.



Barrio de Santa Cruz is the most picturesque and delightful part of the city, with narrow winding cobbled streets and whitewashed houses, was formerly the Jewish quarter. The main sights are the Cathedral and Giralda, formerly a minaret (mosque's tower), the Alcázar (royal fortified palace), The Torre del Oro built by the Almohad dynasty as watchtower and defensive barrier on the river, Parque Maria Luisa built for the 1929 Exposición Ibero-Americana World's Fair and its magnificent bullring La Maestranza.

After the visit check in your hotel and check in hotel.

The old streets of the city of Seville, the river Guadalquivir and all the magic rhythm of the flamenco dance will allow us to take with us an eternal remembrance back home.

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## **DAY 4 SEVILLE - GRANADA:**

After breakfast transportation to Granada. Arrival in the afternoon and proceed for check in hotel. The evening will give you a chance to admire the flamenco art in a very special environment: a Sacromonte gipsy cave. Overnight Granada

## **DAY 5 GRANADA – MALAGA (COSTA DEL SOL):**

After breakfast enjoy your private guided tour to the Alhambra, the stunning Moorish palace, including the Palace of Charles V, a renaissance construction, inside the Nasrid fortification of the Alhambra, as well as the Alcazaba fortress that guarded it and the Generalife gardens.

In the afternoon we continue to Malaga, the capital of the Sun Coast (Costa del Sol). Arrival and check in hotel (you can decide to overnight either in Malaga or in any other city along the coast: Marbella, Fuengirola, Benalmádena, etc)

## **DAY 6 MALAGA – CASABLANCA**

Early in the morning proceed for Algeciras where we will board a ferry to Morocco. Arrival in Tangier and your local team will be waiting for you to drive you to Casablanca. Arrival, transfer to your chosen hotel. Check-in, dinner and accommodation.

## **DAY 7: CASABLANCA-RABAT-MEKNES-FEZ (295 km)**

Visit of the Economic Capital : the Central Market, the Habous district, the Royal Palace, the Mohamed V square, the residential area of Anfa and the outside of the Mosque Hassan II.

Lunch (**optional**) in a seafood restaurant at the Corniche. Departure to Rabat, the Administrative Capital Visit of the Royal Palace (Mechouar), the Ouadaya Garden & Kasbah, the Mohamed V Mausoleum, the Hassan Tower Mosque. Continue to Meknes and visit of the Ismailian capital, which has the longer ramparts in Morocco "40 km": the famous Bab Mansour Door, the Royal Stables and the Jewish quarter. Optional lunch. Departure to the holy city of Moulay Driss via the ruins of Volubilis, the Roman City. Continuation to Fez. Dinner and accommodation.

## **DAY 8: FEZ – MARRAKECH**

Morning is devoted to the visit of the spiritual capital : the Medieval Medina with its Attarine and Bou Anania Medersas, the Nejjarine fountain, the Moulay Idriss mausoleum and the Karaouine Mosque (from outside).

Afternoon departure to Marrakesh. On arrival we will start the visit of Marrakech, the second oldest Imperial city called «the pearl of the south". The historical sightseeing includes the Menara Garden, the Saadien Tombs, the Bahia Palace, the Koutoubia and the Dar Si Said Museum.

Check-in at the hotel. Dinner and accommodation.
